Please note that you would be involved in setting up the network rather than joining a fully institutionalised organisation. To bring the network to the next level, we need your help!

What we are looking for:

- Preferably some experience in organising events and social media advertising
- Ability to work independently and remotely
- Full working proficiency in English
- Ability to work in a team
- Flexibility and reliability

What you will be working on:

- Developing digital infrastructure for the network
- Creating and maintaining social media profiles
- Designing a website and corporate design (with the support of the partner journals)
- Correspondence with member journals and outreach to new journals and professional organisations

- Organising periodic meetings of the member journals
- Support with organisation of student conferences, joint skill-building workshops, and more

What we offer:

- Tasks that enable you to gain experience in the academic publishing, event/conference organisation, international cooperation, outreach and advertising
- A motivated team of students based throughout Europe and potentially beyond
- The chance to join a wider network of international junior journals
- The possibility to get in contact with experts who work in international relations or IR research
- Prospectively workshops on publishing, enhancing research etc.

Since the members are based in different countries, meetings will always take place online and remote work is the standard. We highly welcome applications from people with diverse backgrounds. Please send us your CV (without photo) and a brief statement (about 200-350 words) outlining why you want to work with us on taking the network to the next level via e-mail to applications@yjea.org by 30 June. We are looking for members to contribute to our work for at least one year, at best even longer (pending the success of the network).
